

CHILDREN'S CAST AUDITION INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in being part of our annual holiday tradition! We're so excited that your child has chosen to audition for a role in our Children's Cast.

Please read the following information for details about audition requirements, what to expect from audition day and information about what we expect from these very important cast members during rehearsals and performances. We encourage you to keep this information for your reference.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

In order to be eligible to audition, each child MUST meet the following requirements:

1. He/she must be at least seven years old at the time of the audition.
2. He/she must have had at least one year of dance training.
3. He/she meet the specified height requirements.
4. He/she must submit a completed application form.

AUDITION APPLICATION DEADLINE

Completed applications must be received by mail, email or in-person by Monday, August 19, 2019. Please note that applications must be signed by both parent and child and include a \$30.00 audition fee. We accept cash, check made payable to the Louisville Ballet or credit card via Eventbrite at 2019louisvilleballetnutcrackerauditions.eventbrite.com

Please read height requirements carefully to ensure that your child is present to audition for all eligible roles. Measurements taken on audition day by Louisville Ballet staff will be considered final. Children are expected to audition for all roles for which they meet the height requirements. Please note that our Artistic Staff may release children early or may consider your child for roles outside of their height eligibility. Please send your child with a brown bag lunch in case they are asked to stay past 11:30 am.

AUDITION ATTIRE & APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

Girls – Leotard (**no nude camisoles, please!**), tights or socks and ballet or jazz shoes. All hair must be prepared in a neat bun on the crown of the head, secured with hairpins and hair net prior to the audition.

Boys – T-shirt, jazz pants, biker shorts or tights, ballet or jazz shoes.

Please be mindful of our limited space and potential distractions and send your child with only what is necessary for the audition. Thank you!

PARENT EXPECTATIONS

Because our space is very limited, no parent or guardian may wait inside the building on audition day. We will ask you to provide a phone number where you can be reached that day in the event of an emergency.

Parents should return to our studio building 30 minutes before your child's audition time ends. We will bring your child to our front entrance and call your name once your child has arrived. Children must be signed out by a parent/guardian. No child may leave our studios without their parent/guardian.

Because we take their roles very seriously, we ask that you and your child take your potential participation just as seriously. All Children's Cast members are expected to commit to attending all scheduled rehearsals and performances. Beyond that, we expect our important Children's Cast members to fully commit to giving their best effort when they share studios and the stage with our professional company.
