

SICK POLICY



If Your Child Is Sick

Louisville Ballet follows the same sick guidelines as any school or daycare. If your child has a fever or is vomiting, you need to keep your child home until they are symptom free for 24 hours. If your child arrives at a rehearsal or a performance with these symptoms, they will need to be picked up immediately. This is to ensure the health of all of our dancers.

If your child is sick during the **studio rehearsal schedule** please contact the Nutcracker Children's Cast Manager as soon as possible:

If your child is sick **beginning with the first studio Full Run on Monday, December 9th** and continuing throughout all of the dress rehearsals, student matinees and performances at the Kentucky Center, contact **in this order**:

1. Your Cast Partner. A verbal confirmation is preferred. However, text messaging or e-mailing is acceptable as long as you receive confirmation that your cast partner will replace your dancer.
2. Your child's Cast Leader.

Sending a text message is fine, as long as you receive a return text or verbal confirmation.
